### Formatting an Essay in APA Style

**Title Page, Running Head, and Page Numbers.**

**Font:** Use Times New Roman, 12-point font.

**Margins:** Use 1-inch margins. Do not align the right margin. To set the margins in Microsoft Word, choose Margins in the Page Layout menu.

**Line Spacing:** Double-space the entire document.

**Indenting:** Indent the first line of each paragraph  $\frac{1}{2}$ " by pressing the Tab key once.

**Section Headings:** Use headings to highlight new sections in the paper.

**References:** Include a References page if you cited sources in the paper.

**All submitted Essays may be subjected software that identifies Plagiarism.**

### **ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE CONSIDERED PLAGIARISM:**

- Turning in someone else's work as your own
- Copying words or ideas from someone else without giving credit
- Failing to put a quotations in quotation marks
- Giving incorrect information about the source of a quotation
- Changing words, but, copying the sentence structure of a source without giving credit
- Copying so many words or ideas from a source that it makes up the majority of your work, whether you give credit or not
